Hi,

Following the recent announcement and changes to the Covid Legislation we can confirm clubs can continue to offer organised bowling activity in a Covid-safe manner. **Phase 3 falls within the sporting exemption allowed.**

Clubs should continue to follow the Phase 3 guidance and be aware that this is now backed up by the legislation changes. You can continue to take part in organised outdoor sports when restrictions on social gatherings are introduced from Monday 14th September.

With the end of the season fast approaching we hope that members are able to get out and enjoy the remainder of the year in a safe controlled way.

Clubs should continue to maintain track and trace records which should be available for 21 days if they are requested by NHS track and trace.
